



DAY CAMP IS **NOT** FOR EVERY DOG

The Barkley's Day Camp is a cage-free environment designed for social dogs to play and have fun. And, **safety is our #1 concern – for your pet...and others**. Unfortunately, due to the increased risks associated with the cage-free environment, Day Camp is NOT for every dog.

The Day Camp environment only remains safe (for our staff and for our dog clients) when strict standards and safety precautions are followed. This means our staff members must be capable of properly handling all guests and controlling them in the event of an emergency. Because dogs are pack animals, one “unsocial” dog can easily spoil the bunch and create chaos. Therefore, it is unfortunate, however, we must not make Day Camp a place for aggressive dogs to learn how to be social.

After consult with the PCSA and our veterinary advisors, the following lists have been compiled as general guidelines:

RESTRICTED BREEDS (evaluated on a case-by-case basis, but typically do not do well in this environment due to strong prey drives, herding behavior, etc.):

- Boxers
- Greyhounds
- German Shepherds

PROHIBITED BREEDS AND MIXES (not able to be admitted to Day Camp for insurance and safety reasons):

- Pit Bulls
- Bull Mastiffs
- Cane Corsos
- Presa Canerios
- Akitas
- American Staffordshire Terriers
- Chow Chows
